TAXES!

Community Action Agency of Delaware County, Inc. (CAADC) is operating free Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) sites for a thirteenth year. This year CAADC will be hosting four sites serving low to moderate income families in Delaware County. All the sites are staffed with IRS trained and certified community volunteers and will aim to serve families who qualify for the Earned Income Tax Credit and the Child Tax Credit. Last year CAADC assisted nearly 900 households with completing their taxes.

The free sites are located at:

- Sharon Hill Commons, 401 Sharon Avenue, Sharon Hill, PA 19079
- The Boothwyn Office, 1414 Meetinghouse Road, Boothwyn, PA 19061

The sites begin operation on January 26th and will continue through April 15th.

All sites are by appointment only with hours occurring Monday through Saturday (days and hours vary at each site)
